WORLD RELIGIONS - 2105310 Grade 9-12, Credit .50

This nine week elective class will examine the core beliefs and history of the following religions: Judaism, Christianity, Islam, Hinduism, Buddhism, Sikhism, and Confucianism. Other faith systems will be examined as time permits.

Students will be able to identify the similarities and differences among the world's major religious traditions, and will understand how these religious systems influenced the history and development of the world. The Holocaust is the second part of this course. They must both be taken together.
