Did you know that if you score 1330 on your SAT, you can qualify for a 100% paid scholarship to a Florida university or college?

Juniors or seniors must have a minimum Grade Point Average (GPA) of 3.0 to be eligible.

All applicants must be planning to pursue an Associates, Bachelor's, or Technical degree from an accredited college or university on a full-time basis upon graduation or in the next 2 years.

Scholarship awards will be based on:

- Successful completion of this application by the deadline (April 23, 2021)
- Demonstrated financial need
- A minimum 3.0 (unweighted) grade point average
- Recent High school report card or transcript
- A personal interview

Semi-finalists will be selected and then be scheduled for a personal interview by the course instructor, Dr. Janjay Gehndyu.

Candidates will be notified by April 29, 2021, for classes to begin on June 5th. All successful candidates and their parents will be required to sign a Learning Contract, indicating their commitment to completion of this program including the requirements to enroll in the SAT Test scheduled for August 28.







- 10. Keep a Sense of Humor


